Landscape Design in Hospital Gardens: The Example of Selcuk University Medical Faculty Hospital

Abstract

The findings show that the examined hospital garden was not designed exactly in accordance with the landscape design principles. With the suggestions developed, this hospital garden can be redesigned in accordance with the landscape design principles and can be made more comfortable for the people who use the hospital garden.
